4 DAYS – 3 NIGHTS

MELBOURNE - GREAT OCEAN ROAD - GRAMPIANS - BALLARAT

DAY 1		
Melbourne to Great Ocean Road		
Depart:	Melbourne	

O/night:	Anglesea
Distance:	114 kilometres

A 30-minute Princes Highway drive and you arrive at Werribee Open Range Zoo in time for an open-air African safari adventure. Motor on to Geelong's glittering waterfront and explore the Bollards Trail before a view-laden lunch on the restaurant strip. Take the Surf Coast Highway to Torquay, the spiritual home of Australian Surfing and onto Anglesea.

Experience Anglesea Golf Club for a round of golf or the legendary kangaroo tours. Enjoy a well-earned night of peaceful snoozing at Great Ocean Road Resort or Sunnymead Hotel in Aireys Inlet.

DAY 2

Great Ocean Road to Grampians

Depart:	Anglesea
O/night:	Halls Gap/Dunkeld
Distance:	Approx 398 kilometres

Tour the coast-hugging road from Anglesea to Apollo Bay. Treat yourself to a thrilling helicopter flight over the dramatic Twelve Apostles and coastline with 12 Apostles Helicopters, before driving on to Warrnambool

Spend a few hours exploring the sea-faring magic of Flagstaff Hill Maritime Museum. Motor north through farmland to Halls Gap and settle in to splendid bush retreat accommodation at D'Alton's Studios or Grampians Getaway Resort.

DAY 3		
Grampians to Ballarat		
Depart:	Halls Gap/Dunkeld	
0/night:	Ballarat	
Distance:	Approx 152 kilometres	

The vast Grampians National Park seems heaven-sent for early-risers. Hike trails for lofty scenery, wildlife glimpses and Australian bushland. Linger over amazing views and a bistro lunch on Halls Gap Hotel's verandah. En route to Ballarat, travel through vinevard-dotted wine country. calling into Best's Wines, Grampians Estate, Mount Langi Ghiran or Pomonal Estate to sample local vintages.

Ballarat Wildlife Park is home to dozens of native animals including more than 100 free-roaming kangaroos you can wander amongst. Come evening, enjoy dinner, drinks and priority seating with a VIP package to Sovereign Hill's new evening sound-andlight spectacular AURA. Spend an indulgent night at the Mecure Ballarat Hotel or the luxurious Hotel Vera.
